




Space for improvements (2/3)

→ Other Conservations




- CCH ... Cetaceans Critical Habitats

- FRA ... Fishery Restricted Area
- IMMA ... Important Marine Mammal Area
- OECM ... Other Area-based Effective Conservation Measures
- PSSA ... Particularly Sensitive Sea Area
- SPAMI ... Specially Protected Areas of Mediterranean Importance



Space for improvements (3/3)

→ Activation of the ecological component of the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ)





Biodiversity most valuable areas and 12/24 miles of shorelines

Possible next steps – towards an Action Plan

At the local/national level:

MPAs should be:

- more
- •more "no-take" areas
- expanded
- •inter-connected
- complemented (Natura 2000, OECMs, Biodiversity important areas: CCH, EBSA, IMMA, SPAMI...), but also with other non-biodiversity driven designations (FRA, PSSA...)

At the transboundary level:

Transboundary cooperation

At the EUSAIR level:

- Technical and Advisory Panel
- Permanent body for Marine protected areas within the EUSAIR
